NJDA ADVISORY

Proposed Settlement in Class Action Suit -Kirsch v. Horizon Blue Cross Blue Shield of NJ

Following a mass mailing concerning the above-referenced subject, which contained a Notice of Proposed Settlement, a Claim Form and Instructions Regarding the Claim Form, the Association received a number of inquiries. The NJDA was not a party to that lawsuit and did not make the mailing. However, to clarify and simplify the matter for NJDA members, if the Court approves the proposed settlement (the hearing presently is scheduled to be held on July 23, 2012), a fund will be established by Horizon from which eligible dentists will receive a maximum one-time payment of \$167.70, provided, however, that said payment will be proportionately reduced if more than 17,000 valid claims are submitted. Dentists may receive one payment only.

Claims for Class Member Payments must be submitted in accordance with Claim Form Instructions on the form authorized in the settlement agreement. To be eligible, a dentist must have rendered services to a Horizon Plan Member anytime between May 26, 1999 and April 13, 2012, for which Horizon paid a benefit of at least One Cent (\$0.01). In addition, the envelope returning the claim document(s) must be mailed to the Settlement Administrator with a post marked date of no later than August 13, 2012. The settlement applies to all dentists, whether participating or non-participating.

Any dentist who does not want to be a Class Member must Opt-Out from the Class and the settlement by sending a written request (in the form prescribed in the Notice of Proposed Settlement) which is received by the Settlement Administrator no later than June 29, 2012.

Secretary's Report (Dr. McTaggart):

The Component Society Nominations were sent in to NJDA. Signatures are required by the president, president elect and state trustee (Drs. Kukucka, Gupta and Shah) to finalize documentation.

NJDA Trustee Report (Dr. Shah):

BOT Minutes for 3/21/12:

The Board approved the nomination of Dr. David Lipani as Central's representative to the Council on Membership. A motion was made, seconded and ADOPTED by the Board (Vote #1 BT-12-3-6) to approve the Consent Calendar

A motion was made, seconded and unanimously ADOPTED by the Board (Vote #2 BT-12-2-7) to remove the Committee on Medicaid from the Rules of the Board and incorporate it as a Sub-Committee of the Council on Dental Benefit Programs.

A motion was made, seconded and unanimously ADOPTED by the Board (Vote #3 BT-12-3-8) to join the Association of State and Territorial Dental Directors as an Associate Member and to take the \$300. from the SmileCheck funds. This money is from a grant allocation so it must be approved by Delta.

The Member Conduct Policy has five punishments censor, probation, suspension, expulsion and/or removal from office. It is Dr. Chinoy's intention to make changes to the NJDA Bylaws to enforce this, have it approved by the Board and then send it to the House of Delegates in June to be adopted.

A number of Board members brought up the subject of a company called Groupon. This could involve fee splitting. Art Meisel reported that the State Board of Dentistry was looking into the matter.

ADOPTED by the Board (Vote #5 BT-12-3-10) to change the Rules of the Board on page 23 under Invited guests and their spouses/guest to list The President-Elect of the ADA (if he cannot attend, the Council has the authorization to substitute).

Dr. Michael Messana reported that SmileCheck is ongoing. Approximately twenty schools and some 700 students have been screened. He acknowledged that Dr. Ethan Glickman and Dr. Bob Giantomas have been very helpful in assisting with this project. They have been talking about the budget, Delta gave SmileCheck \$10,000

Council on Dental Benefits (Dr. Sirota):

1. Guardian COB: Staff reported on a situation in which Guardian, as secondary carrier, did not pay the full patient liability after payment by the primary, even though that amount was less than it would have paid if primary. When the dental office called Guardian, the representative stated that the COB rule did not apply to dental plans. NJDA faxed the regulations to Guardian's legal department, but no response was received. NJDA then contacted the NJ Department of Banking and Insurance (DOBI), which is investigating. (Subsequent to

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Phone (856) 234-3536 (800) 400-8550 Fax (856) 727-0277 the meeting, DOBI informed NJDA that Guardian acknowledged that it had not been coordinating appropriately based on the NJ regulation that was adopted ten years ago. DOBI has not decided what, if any, further action will be taken).

- 2. MetLife Payment Delays: Staff updated the council on the on-going problems with MetLife delaying payment for entire claims if routine restorations are sent on the same claim and did not include x-rays. To date, all of the plans are self-insured and exempt from state law that forbids such practices.
- 3. MetLife Tricare Dental Contract: The council discussed MetLife's assumption of the Tricare dental plan for military dependents and reservists effective May 1, 2012. (United Concordia will continue to administer the Tricare plan for active duty personnel).
- 4. Horizon BCBS National Dental Network: The council discussed the letter and contract amendment from Horizon BCBS New Jersey, which was sent certified mail to participating dentists, relating to a new national BCBS dental network. It appears to be a mandatory program, since even if dentists do not sign and return the amendment, Horizon will assume they accept it unless they submit a letter to terminate as a participating dentist with Horizon.

Legislative updates:

- 1. The hygiene general supervision legislation passed the Senate unanimously and now has to come out of Assembly committee and then be voted upon by the Assembly, who passed it in the 2011 legislative session. It is expected to be passed by the end of May and then go to the Governor.
- 2. The NJ Health Ins. Exchange Legislation allows dental only plans to be sold on the exchange separate from medical plans (Obama Care allows states to create their own exchanges rather than go into the federal exchange). By separating the premiums for medical and dental, this will allow the dental only companies (like Delta) to compete for the requirements for all children to be covered by dental insurance when Obama Care takes effect.
- 3. Another bill gives immunity to people using AEDs to save a life (a Good Samaritan Law). Dental offices are not required to have AEDs.
- 4. Water Fluoridation bill has been reintroduced in both the Assembly and Senate.

Lawsuit updates:

- 1. We lost the Horizon assignment of benefits suit and are now attempting to accomplish the goals legislatively.
- 2. Regarding insurance plans setting maximum allowable charges for non-covered services, the Appellate Court agreed that the Dept. of Banking and Ins. doesn't have jurisdiction over this but does over establishing contracts. So it is OK to bundle non-covered services with dental insurance plan contracts
- 3. Beach Bum Tanning providing tooth bleaching services the Appellate division reversed the trial court and sent it to the State Board of Dentistry to decide if Beach Bum is practicing dentistry.

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



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
