Board of Trustees meeting 11/16/2016

New Business:

*A new VOIP phone system has been installed at NJDA. This will make it more efficient and cost effective. There were some glitches in the beginning but it seems to be working well.

*A survey was sent out from Mr. Meisel to gather information from individual offices regarding health insurance being offered in our offices. There is a potential for dental practices to join a MEWA-Multiple Employer Welfare Arrangement.

This is a multiple employer arrangement for smaller employers to get group health and other insurance benefits for their employers. By pooling contributions together, smaller employers are better positioned to offer the best benefit packages from insurance companies. This is in the very early stages of researching this option.

*4th district trustee Jeffrey Cole will be running for ADA president. There is surplus money from Dr. Feinberg's campaign for ADA and that will be returned to that race. We will revisit if we want to donate more to the campaign.

*ADA reimbursement for delegates was discussed. The rules state when the meeting is in the eastern states, there is no contribution for the night of the last meeting due to close proximity of home.

*Dr Deryck Pham in Mays Landing has started Veterans Smile Day. This is turning into a successful national event to help our veterans in need. Please consider volunteering November 2017. ADA recognized his efforts this year.

*our 12 EBAs are requesting more exposure with the membership. They will be offered one visit per component and NJDA will reimburse each component \$1200 for the officers visitation meeting to allow EBAs access. (if all or none come we get the same amount) We are free to sell to non EBAs. The MOCDS officers have agreed to this arrangement with the understanding that the non-dues revenue from EBAs is critical.

OLD BUSINESS:

*Our OPIOID guidelines have been well received by membership, the press & our state legislatures. Other states have asked if they can use our guidelines for their own states.

*we may be getting a blog & podcasts. Try to visit our NJDA website & social media.

* there is consideration to improve the job searches & listings on the NJDA website.

* membership efforts are always being worked on. They are working on improving new dentists happy hours and coupling it with mentoring events.

*dues waivers- this is consistently an issue. NJDA wants the components to have a bigger role in waiver requests. They are

working on uniformed info with Q & A that can be distributed to members when they are requesting waivers.

*The B2B was a very successful event. The partners are very happy.

* Our partner Tristate Safety will be offering CPR & OSHA courses for all members at very reasonable fees. This will be monthly.

* NJDA will be using a new registration company for registering all events. There is a flat annual fee of 12K. This is more efficient then hiring multiple times for each event. They are also able to store data and create profiles on each member and track the type of courses they register for.

* Please schedule to be at the ANNUAL SESSION this year May 5,6 in Newark. The delegates meeting will be the 6th and we hope all delegates will be present.

*Be aware that stericycle has had issues with over billing. Art is looking into this practice.

Food & Drug Administration BANS all Powdered Surgeon’s and Examination Gloves - Effective January 18, 2017 powdered surgeon’s gloves, exam gloves and powder for lubricating gloves are banned for use in dental and medical settings. According to the FDA, this ban is effective for all such gloves “that are already in commercial distribution and for these devices that are already sold to the ultimate user,

Federal EPA Issues Final Rule on Amalgam - The US Environmental Protection Agency released a final ruling on dental amalgam waste, that requires many dentists to install separators. According to the American Dental Association House of Delegates, which supports the EPA on this issue, the rule includes reasonable exemptions, a phase in period and consideration for practices that have already installed devices. Amalgam Separator Registrations Were Due December 31, 2016 - Amalgam separators must be registered with the NJ Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) by December 31st each year. The NJDEP does not issue a reminder. If you have not yet done so, register immediately.
