The meeting was called to order by Dr. Safari at 7:00 p.m.

President's Report (Dr. Safari):

The Budget was discussed and approved. We will most likely be in the red due to loss of membership. It is critical we work on membership in our component. Our other source of income is from EBAs and we must maintain those relationships. The fat has been trimmed as much as possible in the expense columns.

That is a success to do it again but perhaps differently. It was a sold out event. Sponsors & members were happy.

5- 2018 annual session. May 17-19 in Newark. Please be present. Jan 1st registration opens. Please remember each component should donate 500\$ for legislative luncheon. We have done this in the past.

6- Benefits- Do you have a signature on file? Where? Each office should redo it annually. Update HIPPA agreements annually as well. Consent form on NJDA website can be used. If you take Medicare- you have to look up common languages spoken in your region and provide. ETF is not mandatory in NJ

7- Peer review- 10/4 was the training course. 44 cases. 36 GP. 4 ortho- 1 OS

8- COGPA- Dr. Jeff Van Drew, is running for the legislature. ADPAC
